Dear Parishioners,

When I was a teenager, I was beaten twice by Hindu fundamentalists because I was a Christian. I still know the names of those who hurt me. For years, I clung to anger, convinced my pain justified my refusal to forgive. Even now, forgiveness feels incomplete; the scars linger. Today's Gospel cuts deeply: "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you... pray for those who abuse you." Jesus does not ask us to pretend the wounds aren't real. He asks us to choose mercy anyway—not because our pain is small, but because God's love is larger.

This passage reminds me that forgiveness is not a single act, but a daily surrender. When Jesus says, "Be merciful, as your Father is merciful," He invites us into a love that transcends fairness. It's a love that gives without expecting repayment, prays even for persecutors, and trusts God to heal what we cannot. Our journey is unfinished, but each small step—praying for those who hurt us, releasing bitterness—draws us closer to the heart of Christ. Let us ask for the grace to love as God loves: recklessly, relentlessly, and without measure.

Let us pray for Pope Francis: Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, continues treatment for bilateral pneumonia, with a stable yet gradual recovery. Despite health challenges, he remains prayerful and engaged in limited work. Let us unite in fervent prayer for his healing and strength.

Now, it's our turn to show our heartfelt gratitude for their lifelong dedication.
